TRANSPORTATION/INFRASTRUCTURE:

- Support for respective phasing studies of the Catawba Crossings, Belmont/Mount Holly Connector, and CATS light rail extension projects as opportunities for connectivity enhancement and congestion reduction
- Investment in the deployment of high-speed internet throughout Gaston County to drive business, remote work, and entrepreneur growth and diversification

WORKFORCE/TALENT

- Expanded financial support of the GBA Talent Partnership initiative focused on addressing specific industry talent needs through innovative recruitment, education, and placement efforts
- Support for Career & Technical Education and Apprenticeship programs to strengthen local talent pipelines
- Advancement of appropriate child care funding sources, structures, policy reforms, and innovations aimed at addressing growing workforce demands
